The main aim of our Project is to improve the skills and employability of young people with special attention to those with fewer opportunities by creating Local Intergenerational Civic Councils. The CIA Project makes the relationship between young and old extremely positive, allowing on the one hand the development of personal and professional skills based on the exchange of knowledge and experiences between young and old through Local Intergenerational Civic Councils, with the aim of improving the employability of young people and allow them access to civic decision-making, with special reference to the group of young people who, due to their poor training, experience or level of skills development, have greater difficulties in entering the labour market.

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In the period between September and December 2020, the different activities planned and adapted have been carried out according to the current pandemic situation.

Thus, the main milestone that was to take place in this period was the meeting in Brasov, which could not be held in person due to the restrictions imposed by the countries in the fight against the disease.

It was held online in order to continue the project as planned, which was the review of intellectual outputs 1 and 2. Thus, it presented the final version of the Operational Manual and the Training Module. Likewise, the progress of the two practical guides belonging to the second intellectual output were reviewed: the Practical Guide for Facilitators of Intergenerational Civic Agents and the Practical Guide for Interlocutors of Intergenerational Civic Agents.

And, the project continues, waiting for the evolution of both the pandemic and the restrictions to be able to hold the next face-to-face meetings in person and not by videoconference; Follow-up videoconferences are held periodically. After intellectual outputs 1 and 2, the following product should be developed: the interactive platform, which we will talk about in the next Newsletter.

Meanwhile, the partners carry out several dissemination activities: press releases, meetings (with all security measures) ... One of the most innovative dissemination activities was the participation of the project leader, the FUE-UJI, in the #ErasmusDays that took place through the Facebook Social Network on October 16.
