The main aim of our Project is to improve the skills and employability of young people with special attention to those with fewer opportunities by creating Local Intergenerational Civic Councils. The CIA Project makes the relationship between young and old extremely positive, allowing, on the one hand, the development of personal and professional skills based on the exchange of knowledge and experiences between young and old through Local Intergenerational Civic Councils, to improve the employability of young people and allow them access to civic decision-making, with special reference to the group of young people who, due to their poor training, experience or level of skills development, have greater difficulties in entering the labour market.

OBJECTIVES

- To promote the employability of young people through intergenerational local civic participation.
- To foster an open and participatory dialogue between young people, older people and local stakeholders.
- To promote through intergenerational councils the active participation of young people in civic decision-making.
- To support employability actions through active youth-adult cooperation.
- To use emotional intelligence as a means of developing interpersonal skills and competences through older young relationships.

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In the period between January and April 2021, as in the previous months of the project, different activities have been developed in the pandemic situation.

The consortium has focused on the realization of IO3, which is the collaborative platform for the promotion of CIA's.

Said collaborative platform on the Internet will allow the exchange of opinions, ideas, good practices among the facilitators and interlocutors of the CIA's.

At the same time, it will make it possible to establish collaborative links between youth workers, employment agents, employment NGOs, and public authorities and institutions.

In the collaborative platform, already programmed and developed, the intellectual products and other training documents related to the object of our project will be published.

All partners have collaborated with INNETICA (the leading organization of this intellectual project) providing their suggestions regarding the improvement of said platform, intervening in everything related to its validation for its better functioning.

Meanwhile, various online meetings have been held to plan the various activities of the project.

On the other hand, the training activity that will take place in person in Castellón at the Jaime I University has been scheduled for July 5th to 9th and in which representatives of partner organizations and young people from all participating countries in the project will participate (Spain, Portugal, Romania, Poland and Turkey).

In this way, we will begin to carry out the face-to-face activities planned in the last phase of our project.
